Working with this position are teams comprised of Pipe Layers, Operators, Lead Operators, Foreman, Senior Foreman, Superintendent and other Labor Technicians.

PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Assemble pipe, fittings, valves and other related components according to plans
- Construct underground structures
- Assist in installation of pumps, instruments, gate valves, and other water hardware
- Assist with commissioning of completed water and wastewater systems
- Perform daily safety assessments and follow strict safety guidelines
- Communicate safety concerns to Foreman and/or Superintendent
- Communicate effectively with co-workers and supervisors
